I was out for four days on the Centre Island clearing a helicopter land pad and had quite a good flight in and out of the island. Beautiful white sand and no flies or ~~and~~ insects, but you could not swim because sharks infest the waters. I speared three small sharks in about a foot of water so we had curried shark and rice for dinner. Mark would have had a whale of a time here.

be picking it up. also Peggy send me about your packets of tobacco as soon as possible but put % National Maps on all mail.
